**Section 1.** A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11000, a "State Grants" Fund, Accounting No. 11955 for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of state grants awarded for general government purposes.

**Section 2.** Monies received from state awards for general government purposes shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "State Grants" Fund, Accounting No. 11955, in the amount not to exceed the amounts awarded by the state grantors as described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Mayor or his or her designate or other authorized officials. This is a non-lapsing fund.

**Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
