13	WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver passed Ordinance No. 1420 in Series 2018 to			
14	compile and codify the fund plan, tax imposition, and tax remittance portions of the four sales and			
15	use tax increases approved by the people of the City and County of Denver; and			
16	WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver wishes to create a special revenue fund to			
17	receive this additional sales tax revenue and administer the new program;

22	Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in	the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue		
23	Fund Series, Accounting No. 15000, a "Parks, Trails,	and Open Space" Fund, Accounting No. 15828,		
24	for the purpose of receiving and accounting for the Pa	irks, Trails, and Open Space Program's portion		
25	of sales and use tax receipts.			
26	Section 2. Monies received from Denver sales	and use tax collections which are determined		
27	to be the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Program's po	ortion of such collections, as well as any interest		
28	earned on said monies, shall be deposited into the	Treasury of the City and credited to Special		
29	Revenue Fund No. 15000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal			
30	Code of the City and County of Denver, and specifically to Accounting No. 15828-7000000.			

Program Fund, Accounting No. 15828, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Department

of Parks and Recreation. Authorized expenditures and administrative spending caps for Accounting

Section 3. Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Parks, Trails, and Open Space"

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No. 15828 include those stipulated in article XII of Chapter 39 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code, as amended by Referred Measure 2A and any subsequent amendments. This is an appropriated, non-lapsing fund.

Section 4. For the year 2019, there is hereby appropriated to the appropriation account hereinafter designated in the amount of money following such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

Starting in 2020, expenditures for the "Parks, Trails, and Open Space" Program Fund shall be authorized by the annual appropriation ordinance.

Section 5. To ensure that the correct amount of revenue is dedicated to this voter-approved program, the amount appropriated each year shall be increased or decreased by the difference between (1) the prior year's appropriation that was based upon estimated revenues and (2) the actual revenues received in the prior year as determined by the annual audit of the City's financial statements, per fiscal year-end close.

Section 6. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
