A B I L L

FOR AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF THE PUBLIC ALLEY IN BLOCK 22, KASSERMAN'S ADDITION TO ~~THE CITY OF~~ DENVER, LYING BETWEEN THE NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF LOTS 1 TO 5, BOTH INCLUSIVE IN SAID BLOCK 22, AND THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF LOT 8 IN WHEELER'S RESUBDIVISION OF A PORTION OF BLOCK 22, KASSERMAN'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF DENVER, IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

WHEREAS, The Manager of Improvements and Parks has heretofore made the following order and direction, to-wit:

"It is hereby found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity do not now require that portion of the public alley in Block 22, Kasserma's Addition to ~~the City of~~ Denver, in the City and County of Denver, in the State of Colorado, lying between the northeasterly line of Lots 1 to 5 both inclusive in said Block 22, and the southwesterly line of Lot 8 in Wheeler's Resubdivision of a portion of Block 22, Kasserma's Addition to the City of Denver, and extending from the northwesterly line of Erie Street (formerly 4th Street) to the produced northwesterly line of Lot 8 in said Wheeler's Resubdivision extended southwesterly, and the same is hereby vacated, reserving however, to the City and

County of Denver at all times, the right to construct, maintain and remove sewers and water pipes and their appurtenances, and to authorize the construction, maintenance and removal of the same therein and thereon, and subject to the continued right of the owners to maintain and operate existing Electric Light and Power Lines, Gas Mains and Pipes.

And the Council of the City and County of Denver is hereby requested to give effect to this order by the passage of a suitable ordinance.

Done at Denver, in the State of Colorado this 7<sup>th</sup> day of October. A. D. 1931.

NOW, THEREFORE:

Section 1: That the action of the Manager of Improvements and Parks, as set forth in the foregoing order, is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 2: That that portion of the public alley in Block 22, Kasserman's Addition to ~~the City of~~ Denver, in the City and County of Denver, in the State of Colorado, lying between the northeasterly line of Lots 1 to 5 both inclusive in said Block 22, and the southwesterly line of Lot 8 in Wheeler's Resubdivision of a portion of Block 22, Kasserman's Addition to the City of Denver, and extending from the northwesterly line of Erie Street (formerly 4th Street) to the produced northwesterly line of Lot 8 in said Wheeler's Resubdivision extended southwesterly, be, and the same is hereby vacated, reserving to the City and County of Denver at all times

the right to construct, maintain and remove sewers, water pipes and their appurtenances, and to authorize the construction, maintenance and removal of the same therein and thereon, and subject to the continued right of the owners to maintain and operate existing Electric Light and Power Lines, gas Mains and Pipes.

Section 3: In the opinion of the Council, this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and public safety, and shall therefore be in full force and effect from and after its passage and final publication.
