Executive Session. In accordance with section 2-34 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code, City Council may enter into an executive session upon a two-thirds vote in open session of those members present. Unless otherwise excluded by the Members of City Council, only the Members of City Council, the Mayor, city attorney(s), and staff who are designated by City Council or the Mayor as essential to the executive session may be present. No staff person may attend in the place of a Council Member. Council Members may not disclose information discussed only in executive session to any person not present during the executive session. If a matter discussed in executive session is subsequently before City Council for formal action, nothing in this rule prohibits a Council Member from stating his or her position or opinion on the matter, but the Council Member may not divulge confidential information received during the executive session.
