8 **For an ordinance authorizing the purchase of capital equipment from the**
9 **Denver Police Department Federal Grants Fund.**

11 **WHEREAS**, City Council approved Resolution No. 19-0075 to accept the Grant Agreement
12 between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America Department of Justice
13 for the “Denver Police Crime Laboratory’s Multidisciplinary Analysis of Evidence to Increase
14 Laboratory Efficiency and Capacity Enhancement” program and the funding therefor; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Denver Police Department wishes to use said grant funds to purchase a
16 Liquid Handling Robotic Workstation to meet the objectives outlined in the grant award;

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**

21 **Section 1.** From the Denver Police Department Federal Grants Fund No. 12220, the
22 Executive Director of Safety, or his duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to
23 purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
