35	<b>Section 1</b> . That the proposed Blueprint	Denver (2019), consisting of a document of the same	

name filed with the City Clerk, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, on April 10, 2019, April 23, 2019, as City Clerk Filing No. 20190013, No. 20190013A, is hereby adopted and accepted as an amendment to supplement Comprehensive Plan 2040, pursuant to Section 12-61 of the DRMC.

**Section 2**. That said Blueprint Denver (2019) replaces and supersedes Blueprint Denver 2019 for the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** That this adoption and acceptance of Blueprint Denver (2019), and of any subsequent amendment thereto, in conjunction with Comprehensive Plan 2040, is intended to establish the official guide for officials of the City and County of Denver and private citizens when making decisions affecting the future of land use and transportation in and for the City and County of Denver, as defined in said plan; provided however, that such approval shall not preempt the decision making powers vested by law or administrative directive in the Mayor, the Council or any other official of the City and County of Denver with respect to, but not limited to: a zoning map amendment, a zoning language amendment, a dedication or vacation of a street, alley or other public way, a designation of a park, the issuance of a revocable permit, a conveyance or acquisition of real property by the City and County of Denver, or an appropriation for or construction of a capital improvement; and provided, further that it is expressly understood that judgment must be exercised in the application of Blueprint Denver (2019) in the decision making processes of the Mayor, Council and other officials of the City and County of Denver.
