A BILL

For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Human Services concerning the "Youth Detention Continuum" program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement, between the State of Colorado Department of Human Services Division of Youth Services, and the City and County of Denver, which is identified as Grant Number 20 IKAA 128938, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 201950055, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the Colorado Department of Human Services Division of Youth Services to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 12000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of Safety, is as follows:

Authorization for expenditure of said funds will cover the period from the later of July 1, 2019 or the Effective Date of the contract, to June 30, 2020.

3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
