| 9 | WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 20-18 of the Denver Revised Municipal |
| 10 | Code ("DRMC"), by Ordinance No. 641, Series of 2018, and by voter approval, which was enacted |
| 11 | December 11, 2018, there has been approved the establishment of a fund for the receipt of a portion |
| 12 | of sales tax for the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Program; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 39-223 and Section 39-224, DRMC, that |
| 14 | portion of sales tax paid to the fund shall be used for certain Permitted Uses under the Parks, Trails |
| 15 | and Open Space Program; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 39-224(i), DRMC, within one (1) year of enactment, the |
| 17 | Department of Parks and Recreation shall work with the Department of Parks and Recreation |
| 18 | Advisory Board to hold at least one (1) public hearing; and submit to City Council for approval a five- |
| 19 | year Parks, Trails and Open Space Program Plan for the use and expenditure of the fund established |
| 20 | for the Program; and |
| 21 | WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation has held such public hearings, and |
| 22 | submitted the Plan to the clerk of City Council, 2019 for approval as required, with the final |
| 23 | revised plan submitted to City Council June 7, 2019; and |
| 24 | WHEREAS, a copy of the final revised Plan is available through the Department of Parks and |
| 25 | Recreation; and |
| 26 | WHEREAS, the Parks, Trails and Open Space Program Plan provides guidance regarding |
| 27 | the acquisition of additional land for parks, trails and open spaces; improving and maintaining |
| 28 | existing parks, trails and open spaces; restoring and protecting waterways, rivers, canals and |
| 29 | streams; expanding the urban tree cover in parks, parkways and public rights-of-way; and |
| 30 | implementing the Game Plan for a Healthy City; and |
| 31 | WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 39-224(i), DRMC, such plan for the use and expenditure of |
| 32 | the fund for the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Program shall be approved by City Council. |
| 33 | NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF |

| 35 | Section 1. Council hereby approves the Parks, Trails, and Opens Space Program Plan, 1 |

1 which was submitted as revised June 7, 2019.

2 Section 2.
