7 **For an ordinance amending division 1 of article V of chapter 18 of the D.R.M.C. to**
8 **remove elected officials as persons eligible for paid time off.**

10 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

11 **Section 1.** Subsection (a) of section 18-123, D.R.M.C. is amended by deleting the language
12 stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

13 **Sec. 18-123. - Eligibility.**

14 (a) All officers (~~elected and appointed~~) and employees hired or rehired by the city after
15 December 31, 2009, shall receive PTO as provided in this division, with the exception of:

- 16 (1) Part-time employees who are regularly scheduled to work less than twenty (20) hours
17 per week;
- 18 (2) Members of the classified service of the police and fire departments;
- 19 (3) Employees in the deputy sheriff classifications;
- 20 (4) Employees occupying on-call, temporary, seasonal, or contract positions, or positions in
21 which the incumbent is paid according to the community rate schedule; or employees who meet
22 the requirements of subsection 18-408(j)(7) of this chapter;
- 23 (5) Elected officers.

24 **Section 2.** Effective date and applicability.

25 This bill is effective July 15, 2019 and applies to terms of office commencing on and after
26 that date.
