A BILL

For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the General Government Special Revenue Fund for “City Council Local and Private Grants”.

WHEREAS, the City Council currently lacks a Special Revenue Fund to receive local and private grants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11000, a “City Council Local and Private Grants” Fund, Accounting No. 11608 for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of local and private grants awarded for general government purposes.

Section 2. Monies received from local and private grant awards to City Council for general government purposes shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized for the “City Council Local and Private Grants” Fund, Accounting No. 11608, in the amount not to exceed the amounts awarded by grantors as described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the City Council President or his or her designate or other authorized officials. This is a non-lapsing fund.


Section 4. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
