A BILL

For an ordinance approving the purchase of capital equipment items from the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Special Revenue Fund and from the Denver Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the City Council approved, Ordinance No. 0538, Series of 2019, which adopted the Denver Parks and Recreation 2A Five Year Plan (2020-2024) to utilize the funds from the 2018 Ballot Measure 2A Parks and Open Space Sales Tax, which is dedicated to the improvement and expansion of Denver's parks and recreation system; and

WHEREAS, the Denver Parks and Recreation 2A Five Year Plan includes several capital equipment items; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation is working in coordination with Denver Arts and Venues to purchase a mini-bus for outdoor activation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15828-700000, the Executive Director of Parks and Recreation, or his duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

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Section 2. From the Denver Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15815-3050000, the Director of Denver Arts and Venues, or his duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

Section 3. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
