A BILL

For an ordinance amending Section 14-131, D.R.M.C., pertaining to residency requirements for the municipal public defender commission

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That section 14-131, D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

The municipal public defender commission shall consist of five (5) members appointed by the presiding judge of the Denver County Court. Three (3) members of the commission shall be attorneys admitted to practice law in the state of Colorado, and two (2) members shall be persons not admitted to practice law in the state of Colorado. ~~All members shall be residents of the City and County of Denver.~~ No member of the commission shall be, at the time of or during the term of the appointment, a judge, prosecutor, public defender, or employee of a law enforcement agency.
