**A BILL**

**For an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the Environmental Services Enterprise Fund, transferring cash to the Planned Fleet Special Revenue Fund, and authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Planned Fleet Special Revenue Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, the 2019 Budget outlined an expansion of the City’s Composting Program, which included financing the capital lease of 12 composting trucks; and

**WHEREAS**, the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment has agreed to loan the initial funding for the vehicles needed to expand the Composting Program from the Environmental Services Enterprise Fund;

**WHEREAS**, a 13<sup>th</sup> composting vehicle has been approved in said agreement which was not included in Denver’s Annual Appropriation Ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From appropriations heretofore made from the Environmental Services Enterprise Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded":

2 authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

6 to finance the capital lease of composting trucks to support the expansion of the City's Composting

10 the Executive Director of Public Works, or his duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized  
11 to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
