14	ballot measure 2A increasing the sales and use tax by a rate of 0.25 percent and dedicating the		
15	revenue derived from the tax rate increase to fund Denver parks, trails, and open space projects;		
16	WHEREAS, the City desires to establish a new capital improvement fund series 36000 for		
17	improvements to the Denver parks, trails, and open space projects with such additional tax		
18	revenue; and		
19	WHEREAS, the City desires to establish a new of	capital improvement fund series 37000 for	
20	bond projects.		
21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:		
22	Section 1. The fund series number 36000 named bond projects in Section 20-18(6) fund is

14	authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may
