WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the Denver Zoning Code to add a new Temporary Tiny Home Village use, update outreach procedures related to Large Development Review, and amend regulations regarding parking reductions for certain affordable housing projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined on the basis of evidence and testimony presented at the public hearing that amending the Denver Zoning Code as set forth herein is consistent with the City's adopted plans, furthers the public health, safety and general welfare, and will result in regulations and restrictions that are uniform within all zone districts where Temporary Tiny Home Village uses are permitted, for all development subject to Large Development Review, and within all zone districts where a parking reduction is allowed when providing certain affordable housing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The changes to the Denver Zoning Code as set forth in Clerk File No. 20190075 as filed with the Denver City Clerk on August 29, 2019, and available in the office and on the web page of City Council are hereby adopted and made an official part of the Denver Zoning Code. The changes amend Divisions 8.4, 10.1, 10.4, 11.11, 12.2, 12.3, 12.4, and the use tables in Articles 3-4 and 6-9 of the Denver Zoning Code to establish a new Temporary Tiny Home Village use, update outreach procedures related to Large Development Review, and amend regulations regarding parking reductions for certain affordable housing projects.
