#### Abstract

ABILL For an ordinance authorizing a rescission, a cash transfer, and a supplemental appropriation from the General Contingency Fund to the Liability Claims Special Revenue Fund.


WHEREAS, the City has reached a settlement regarding a lawsuit against the City filed in the United States District Court for the District of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Liability Claims Special Revenue Fund will require additional appropriation to pay for the $\$ 1.55$ million settlement amount;
