# 2019 Storm Drainage Master Plan Update



## **Authorization**

The Denver Storm Drainage Master Plan is prepared in compliance with D.R.M.C. Sec 56-110 requiring City Council adoption no less than every five (5) years. The previous master plan was adopted October 2014.

# **Purpose**

The Storm Drainage Master Plan evaluates citywide flood risk and uses the most up-to-date regional data and trusted engineering standards in developing recommendations for deficient stormwater systems.

#### Goals

- ☑ Update the 2014 Master Plan with current data and information, using latest industry standards
- ☑ Create a host website where information can be easily accessed, understood, and applied by various users
- ☑ Create an interactive GIS-based map with an Address Search to show individual's flood risk
- Build a dynamic stormwater tool that can be functional in project designs to save time and money
- ☑ Update the master plan cost modeling to be accurate and reliable


