This ordinance establishes a new Special Revenue Fund, the Human Rights and Community Partnership Collaboration Fund, Fund Number 11875, within General Government Series, to allow offices and divisions within Human Rights and Community Partnerships to accept funds from other City Funds (such as the General fund or Human Services Special Revenue Fund), donations and other sources of revenue, and to allow for easier collaboration on programming. This ordinance also transfers \$75,000 from Denver Human Services, 13813-5583000, to the newly established Human Rights and Community Partnerships Special Revenue Fund for the purpose of providing additional financial coaching in accordance with an agreement between the Office of Financial Empowerment and Protection and Denver Human Services. Additionally, a companion ordinance will rescind \$50,000 in budget from the General Fund and appropriate said budget into this new fund.
