27	Code of the City and County of Denver.			
28	Section 3. Program expenditures are hereby	authorized for the "Elections Equipment and		
29	Technology Fund", Accounting No. 11874, in the	amount not to exceed the total of deposits		
30	described in Section 2 of this ordinance to be exp	ended by the Clerk and Recorder. Allowable		
31	expenditures include new and replacement elections equipment, leases for elections equipment and
