10	WHEREAS, the Office of the Clerk and Recorder has a need to purchase new and				
11	replacement elections equipment, and to fund equipment leases, storage and other space needs,				
12	one-time start-up civic engagement needs, and technology; and				
13	WHEREAS, companion ordinance CB19-1174 rescinds up to \$1,800,000 from the Clerk				
14	and Recorder's General Fund appropriation, which is available due to year-end savings, and re-				
15	appropriates said budget into the Elections Equipment and Technology Special Revenue Fund, to				
16	be established through this ordinance;

18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY

21	Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue Fund				
22	Series, Accounting No. 11000, an "Elections Equipment and Technology" Fund, Accounting No.				
23	11874, for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program dollars.				
24	Section 2. Monies received from General Fund transfers and other sources of revenue for				
25	Accounting No. 11874 shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special				
26	Revenue Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipa				
27	Code of the City and County of Denver.				
28	Section 3. Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Elections Equipment and				
29	Technology Fund", Accounting No. 11874, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposite				
30	described in Section 2 of this ordinance to be expended by the Clerk and Recorder. Allowable				
31	expenditures include new and replacement elections equipment, leases for elections equipment and				
32	space, storage and other space needs, technology including software or other applications, a	nd			
33	start-up costs related to civic engagement efforts. This Fund is revenue-based and non-lapsir	ıg.
