19	the International Code Council, all errata to the above codes as published by the International Code			
20	Council and the amendments to the above codes and the administration of the Denver Building			
21	Code, as such amendments and administration of the Denver Building Code filed December 20,			
22	2019 <u>20190104</u> July 8, 2019 in City Clerk File Number 2090108 <u>20190104,</u> 20190056 are hereby			
23	adopted collectively as the Denver Building and Fire Code.

25	The current National Electrical Code, as currently adopted by the State of Colorado or as is			
26	from time to time modified, re-enacted or re-adopted by the State of Colorado is hereby adopted as			
27	the electrical code of the City and County of Denver.			
28	Sec. 10-18. – Unlawful to violate codes.			
29	It shall be unlawful to violate any portion of any of the above codes or any order of any building			
30	or fire official enforcing said codes.			
31	<u>Sec. 10-19. – Denver green code.</u>			
32	The Denver Green Code, as filed December 12, 2019 in City Clerk File Number 20190104, is			
33	hereby adopted as a voluntary design and construction code. In order to encourage the use of the			

1	Denver Green Code on a voluntary basis, the buil	ding official is authorized to develop i	incentives	
2	through written policy. Such incentives may inclu-	ude, but are not limited to, expedite	<u>ed permit</u>	
3	processing.
