17	Section 1. There is hereby submitted to the registered electors of the City and County of		
18	Denver for their approval or rejection at a special municipal election held in conjunction with the		
19	coordinated election on November 3, 2020, a proposed amendment to the Charter of the City and		
20	County of Denver, as follows:

22	Effective upon publication and filing v	with the Secretary of State in accordance with	

the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, the following sections of the Charter of the City and County of Denver are amended to read as follows:

§ 7.3.2 – Recommendation by Mayor and cabinet to transfer funds; action by Council; Council initiated supplemental appropriation or transfer.

The Mayor and the cabinet may recommend an ordinance to the City Council transferring funds from one administrative department or office to another, when in their judgment the public service requires it, and the City Council shall act thereon in the same manner as provided in the Charter for the Mayor's annual appropriation ordinance.

During the fiscal year, the City Council, following consultation with the Manager of Finance, may authorize an ordinance appropriating new revenue or revenue in excess of those estimated in the budget, or may authorize a transfer of an unencumbered balance in whole or in part from a specified non-enterprise fund, provided the supplemental appropriation or transfer does not conflict with any

1	uses for which specifically such revenue accrued. In no case may such supplemental appropriation		
2	cause total estimated expenditures, including an ac	ccrued deficit, to exceed total estimated re	venues,
3	including an unappropriated surplus. The City Cou	ncil shall act on such supplemental approp	riation or
4	transfer in the same manner as provided in Section	n 3.3.5 of the Charter.

6	Section 2. The ballot shall contain the follow	owing title and submission clause:

10 11 12	Shall the Charter of the City and County of Denver be amended to give the city council authority to initiate a supplemental appropriation or transfer?		
13	Section 3. The proper officials of the City and County of Denver as are charged with duties		
14	relating to the election shall, before the election, issue such calls, make such certifications and		
15	publications, give such notices, make such appointments, and do all such other acts and things in		
16	connection with the submission of this Charter amendment to the registered electors of the City and		
17	County of Denver at the election as are required by the Constitution and laws of the State of		
18	Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.		
19	Section 4. The ballots cast at such election shall be canvassed and the results ascertained,		
20	determined, and certified in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution and laws of the		
21	State of Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.		
22	Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause, or other portion of this ordinance is held to be		
23	invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity	of the remaining portions of this ordinance	shall
24	not be affected.
