30	Response" Fund, Accounting No. 11878, in the amoun	t not to exceed the total of deposits described		
31	in Section 2 of this ordinance to be expended by the C	hief Financial Officer. Allowable expenditures		
32	include services and supplies, personnel services, and	d capital equipment costs incurred by General		
33	Fund agencies to address the coronavirus pandemic,	as well as transfers to capital project funds for		

coronavirus-response projects. The Chief Financial Officer may close the Fund and transfer unused

balances in the Fund to the General Fund when the City's response to the coronavirus is complete and no outstanding expenses remain. This Fund is revenue-based and non-lapsing.
