A RESOLUTION

Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment concerning the “Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment Carpio-Sanguinette Habitat Restoration” program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, for the “Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment Carpio-Sanguinette Habitat Restoration” program, which is identified as Grant Number 2020*3125, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202053192, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, is as follows:
