7 **For an ordinance adding a new section in Chapter 48, Article IX, Fee on**
8 **Disposable Bags.**

10 **WHEREAS**, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Governor Jared Polis has asked municipalities to
11 suspend bag fees;

12 **WHEREAS**, in response to challenging economic conditions and burdens on retailers and
13 shoppers, Denver's single-use bag fee will be delayed to ensure proper implementation of the law and
14 best serve Denver residents.

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**
16 **DENVER:**

17 **Section 1.** A new Section 48-130 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code shall be added and
18 read as follows:

19 Sec. 48-130. – Effective Date.

20 This article shall become effective on July 1, 2021.


