**WHEREAS**, On April 26, Governor Polis issued a new "Safer at Home" executive order (EO D 2020 044) designed to begin easing the restrictions contained in his previous "Stay at Home" order originally issued on March 25.

**WHEREAS**, On May 8, Denver lifted the city stay-at-home order on Denver residents, but state and local orders still require only critical government functions continue.
