6 7 8	For an ordinance amending the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver to alter the deadlines for retail tobacco store licenses.
9	WHEREAS the emergence of the COVID 19 pandemic in Denver led to an emergency declaration for
10	the City on March 12, 2020; and
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12	WHEREAS due to the emergency declaration and relative risk associated with the COVID 19 pandemic
13	all in-person outreach to tobacco retailers regarding the new Retail Tobacco License ceased on March
14	12, 2020; and
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16	WHEREAS most retail tobacco establishments closed or significantly modified their standard business
17	operations as a result of the COVID 19 pandemic and subsequent public health orders; and
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19	WHEREAS most City operations supporting the procurement of a retail tobacco license were delayed
20	or significantly reduced.
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22	THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the deadlines to receive an exemption from the proximity
23	restrictions shall be January 1, 2021 and the deadline for all establishments to apply and be licensed
24	by shall be altered to July 1, 2021.

26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
27	DENVER:
28	Section 1. That Chapter 24, Article VI, Division 2, of the Deriver Deviced Municipal Code
29 20	Section 1. That Chapter 24, Article XI, Division 2, of the Denver Revised Municipal Code
30 21	shall be to amended by adding the language underlined and deleting the language stricken to read
31	as follows.

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"Sec. 24-420. - License required.

(a) On and after JanuaryJuly 1, 2021, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a retail
tobacco store without first having obtained a valid retail tobacco store license pursuant to this division
2; provided, however, that pre-existing retail tobacco stores that have submitted applications for
licensing under this article as of July 1, 2020July 1, 2021 may continue in operation until the director
takes a final action on the retail tobacco store application.

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Sec. 24-422. - Grounds for denial.

9 (b) In addition to the grounds set forth in chapter 32 of this Code, an application for a retail 10 tobacco store license shall be denied under this division 2 if:

(1) The applicant's proposed location is within one thousand (1,000) feet of any of thefollowing locations:

13a. Any school, with the distance computed by direct measurement in a straight line14from the nearest property line of the land used for the school to the nearest portion of15the building in which the retail tobacco store is proposed to be located;

b. Any city-owned recreation center or city-owned outdoor pool, with the distance
computed by direct measurement in a straight line from the nearest property line of the
land used for the recreation center or outdoor pool to the nearest portion of the building
in which the retail tobacco store is proposed to be located.

20 (2) This subsection (b) shall not apply to any application for a retail tobacco store license 21 submitted on or before July 1, 2020January 1, 2021."
