18	coordinated election on November 3, 2020, a proposed a	amendment to the Charter of the City and

21	Effective upon publication and filing with the	Secretary of State in accordance with	
22	the Constitution and laws of the State of Co	lorado, the following sections of the	
23	Charter of the City and County of Denver are a	mended to read as follows:

27	The Mayor and the cabinet may recommend an or	dinance to the City Council transferring funds	
28	from one administrative department or office to another	, when in their judgment the public service	
29	requires it, and the City Council shall act thereon in the s	same manner as provided in the Charter for	
30	the Mayor's annual appropriation ordinance.		
31	During the fiscal year, the City Council, following co	onsultation with the Manager of Finance, may	
32	authorize an ordinance appropriating new revenue or re	evenue in excess of those estimated in the	
33	budget, or may authorize a transfer of an unencumbered	balance in whole or in part from a specified	
34	non-enterprise fund, provided the supplemental appropr	•	
35	uses for which such revenue specifically accrued. In no	case may such supplemental appropriation

13	Section 3. The proper officials of the City and County of Denver as are charged with duties		
14	relating to the election shall, before the election, issue such calls, make such certifications and		
15	publications, give such notices, make such appointments, and do all such other acts and things in		
16	connection with the submission of this Charter amendment to the registered electors of the City and		
17	County of Denver at the election as are required by the Constitution and laws of the State of		
18	Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.		
19	Section 4. The ballots cast at such election shall be canvassed and the results ascertained,		
20	determined, and certified in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution and laws of the		
21	State of Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.		
22	Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause, or other portion of this ordinance is held to be		
23	invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance shall		
24	not be affected.
