7 **For an ordinance relocating procedural requirements from section 3.3.2 of the**
8 **Charter to the city code if Charter amendments are approved by electors at a special**
9 **municipal election to be held in conjunction with the coordinated election of**
10 **November 3, 2020.**

13 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

14 **Section 1.** That a new section 13-4, D.R.M.C. shall be added the language underlined, to read
15 as follows:


16 **Section 13-4. Council Procedures**

17 City Council shall determine its own rules of procedure, shall keep a public record of its
18 proceedings, shall enter every vote by roll call, and in accordance with open meetings laws of Article
19 III, Chapter 2.

20 **Section 2.** If any section, paragraph, clause, or other portion of this ordinance is held to be
21 invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance shall not
22 be affected.

23 **Section 3.** This ordinance shall only be effective after certification of passage by electors of a
24 referred question revising charter section 3.3.2 at a special municipal election to be held in conjunction
25 with the coordinated election of November 3, 2020, and upon publication and filing of such results with
26 the Secretary of State.
