26	resilience initiatives shall be deposited into the Treasu	ry of the City and credited to Special		
27	Revenue Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised			
28	Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.			
29	Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized for	or the "Climate Federal Grants" Fund,		
30	Accounting No. 11010, in the amount not to exceed the ar	mounts awarded as described in Section		
31	2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Office of Climate Action,			
32	Sustainability and Resiliency or his or her designate or other authorized officials. This Fund is			
33	sponsor-funded and non-lapsing.
