This office has investigated the request of City and County of Denver, dated June 17th, 2020 on behalf of First Creek Village Metropolitan District for the relinquishment of said easement.

This matter has been coordinated with Asset Management; Emergency Management; Comcast; City Councilperson Gilmore, District 11; Community Planning & Development: Planning Services; Historic Preservation/Landmark; Denver Water; Denver Fire Department; City Forestry; Parks and Recreation; DOTI: ER Transportation and Wastewater, DES Transportation and Wastewater, Construction Engineering, Policy and Planning, TES Signing and Striping, Survey; Metro Wastewater Reclamation District; Regional Transportation District; Colorado Department of Transportation; CenturyLink; and Xcel Energy, all of whom have indicated no objection to the proposed easement relinquishment.

As a result of these investigations, it has been determined that there is no objection to relinquishing the subject easement.


Description of Proposed Project: Request for an Ordinance to relinquish the 409 square foot access and improvements easement in its entirety located at 5191 Yampa St. that was originally granted in the Permanent Easement document, Recordation No. 2020023588.

Background: The City provided the standard easement document to First Creek Village Metropolitan District to grant an easement for the described area to the City. However, the Grantor altered the easement language, signed it and recorded it without the City's approval of the language. Additionally, the easement was signed and recorded prior to Grantor taking ownership (deed) of the property and was not authorized to grant the subject easement. Therefore, the City is requesting the easement be relinquished and, thereafter, requiring the property owner to grant a new easement for the same described area using the approved standard easement document.
