Planning and Development, is seeking to establish an Urban Redevelopment Area to support the proposed redevelopment through the approval of an Urban Redevelopment Plan.

Staff with the City and DURA are drafting an Urban Redevelopment Plan and Cooperation Agreement authorizing the creation of the 1840 Grant Street Urban Redevelopment Area and the use of Tax Increment Financing by DURA. State law requires a public hearing be held prior to City Council's consideration of establishing an Urban Redevelopment Plan, with 30 days' prior notice. It is anticipated that this hearing would be conducted on October 20, 2020.

DURA will be asking Council Committee to approve the resolution on consent at the September 1, 2020 meeting. A presentation to the Finance & Governance Committee for the approval of the Urban Redevelopment Plan will be scheduled for September 15, 2020 ahead of the anticipated October 20, 2020 public hearing at City Council.
