In 2018, DEN signed contracts with Burns & McDonnell (BMCD) Engineering to provide on-call commissioning services relating to DEN's capital improvement projects for a three-year term.

This 1st amendment is to extend the contract with BMCD for an additional 24 months with no additional funds added. This is to cover work needed to continue commissioning services as the next procurement will be delayed easing DEN's overall operating budget. This will continue on-call commissioning services for capital improvement projects construction contracts. All projects will be completed by individual task order. The current contract term is three years and a two-year extension is being requested as part of this amendment. The contract value is \$2,000,000.00 encumbered by task order. The on-call commissioning services may include pre-design, design, construction and post-occupancy commissioning services as required per task order. This amendment will not increase contract capacity.
