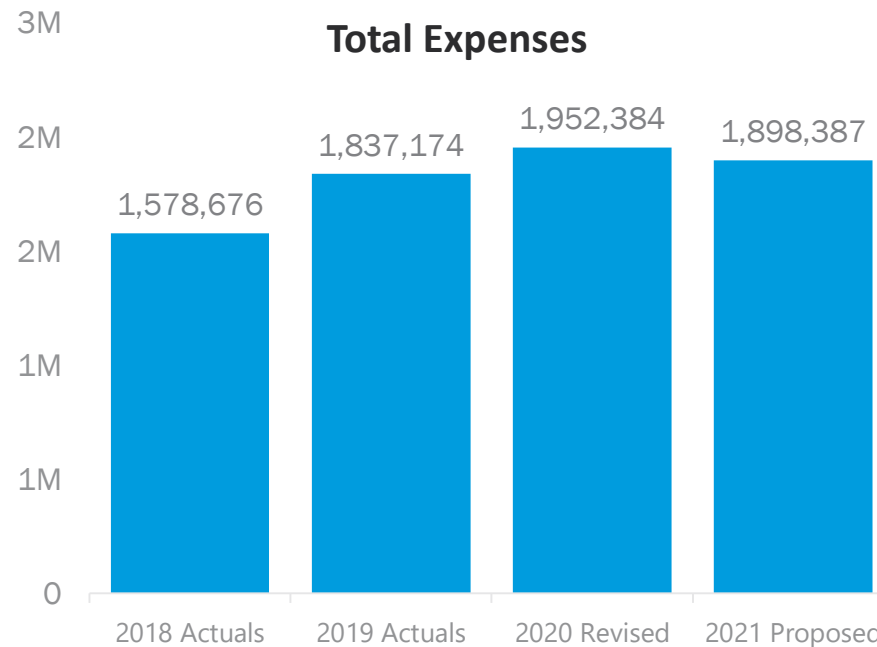
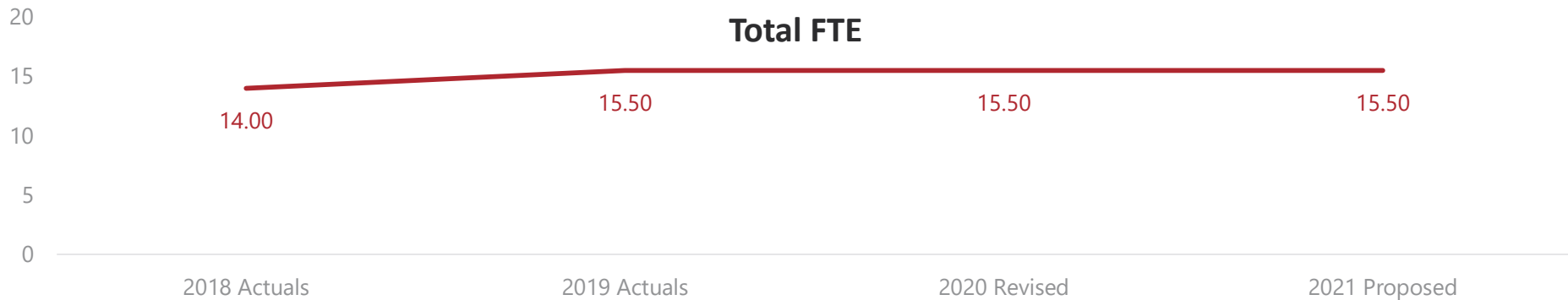

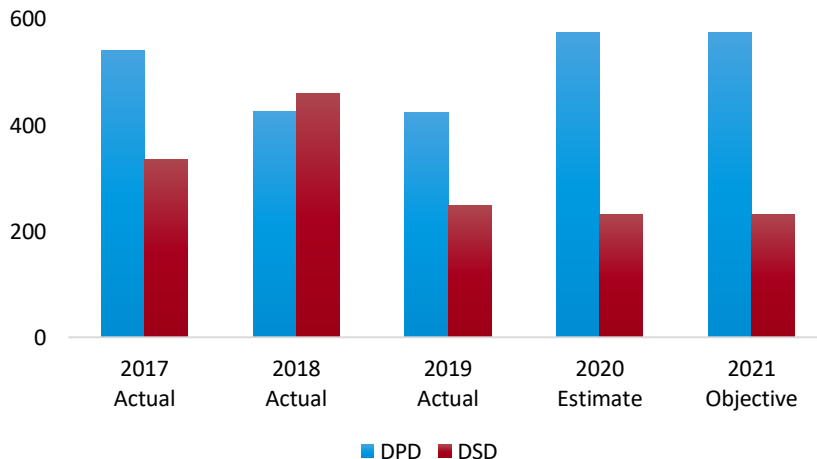


Complaint Monitoring

Key Metrics

- Actively monitoring and reviewing investigations of sworn personnel in the DPD and DSD
- Making recommendations regarding administrative action, including possible discipline for such sworn personnel

Review of DPD Responses to the George Floyd Demonstrations



George Floyd Review Update

- In early June 2020, the OIM received two letters from City Council members requesting that the OIM review the DPD's responses to the George Floyd demonstrations in Denver. The OIM accepted.
- The OIM shared comprehensive requests for information. From the DPD:
 - Policy and training documents for crowd control and use of force
 - All body-worn camera, HALO, and helicopter videos
 - Complete audio recordings of all police radio channels used
 - Operational plans, rosters, and after-action reports
 - All officer statements, use of force reports, and crowd dispersal orders
 - Inventories of all less-lethal equipment and munitions used
 - Training and certification records for officers who used less-lethal equipment
 - All reports of injury to officers and community members
 - All arrest data

- From other Departments:
 - Information from Denver Health, the Denver Fire Department, and the Denver Sheriff Department about their activities during the demonstrations
 - Documentation about all outside jurisdictions, the support they provided, and the equipment they used
- During the summer, the OIM reviewed most of this voluminous material. We also conducted dozens of interviews and are now preparing our findings and conclusions.

Outreach and the Youth Outreach Project

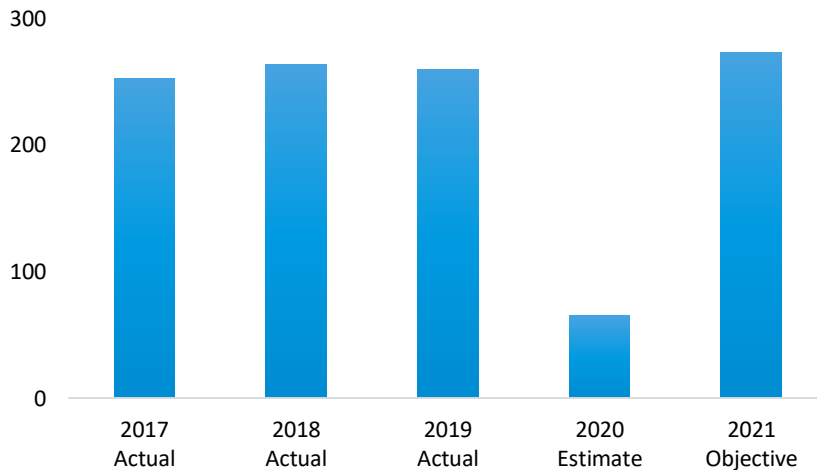


Outreach and YOP

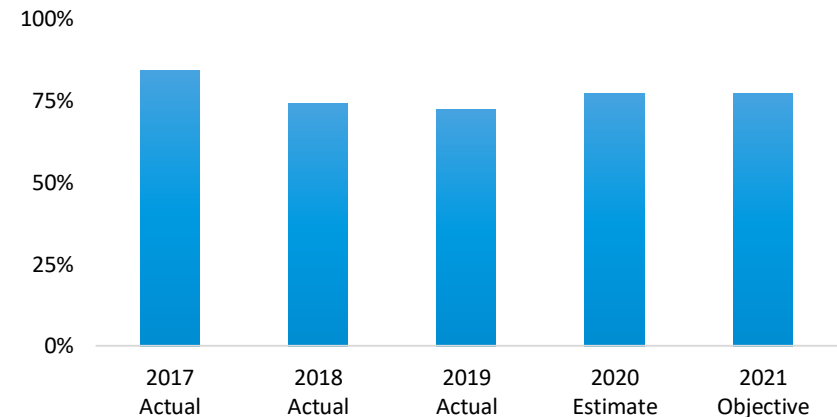
Key Metrics
