11	Section 1. Upon consideration of the recom	mendation of the Executive Director of the					
12	Department of Transportation and Infrastructure that an ordinance be enacted for the purpose of						
13	assessing the annual costs of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and replacement						
14	of Delgany Street Local Maintenance District ("Delgany Street"), for the upcoming year, upon the						
15	real property, exclusive of improvements thereon, benefited, the Council finds, as follows:						
16	(a) A local maintenance district providing	for the continuing care, operation, repair,					
17	maintenance and replacement of Delgany Street, was created by Ordinance No. 755, Series of 2002;						
18	(b) The annual cost of the continuing o	care, operation, repair, maintenance and					

replacement of Delgany Street is \$21,350.00, which amount the Executive Director of the
Department of Transportation and Infrastructure has the authority to expend for the purposes stated
herein;

(c) The Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure has
 complied with all provisions of law relating to the publishing of notice to the owners of real properties
 to be assessed and to all persons interested generally, and the Council sitting as a Board of
 Equalization has heard and determined all written complaints and objections, if any, filed with the
 Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure;

(d) The real property within the Delgany Street will be benefited in an amount equal to or
in excess of the amount to be assessed against said property because of the continuing care,
operation, repair, maintenance and replacement of said Delgany Street.

30 **Section 2.** The annual cost of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and 31 replacement of Delgany Street to be assessed against the real properties, exclusive of improvements 32 thereon, benefited are hereby approved.

33 **Section 3.** The annual costs of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and 34 replacement of Delgany Street in the amount of \$21,350.00 are hereby assessed against the real 35 properties, exclusive of improvements thereon, within said local maintenance district as follows:

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NOTE: Where a series of lots is followed by "inclusive", the amount appearing after the series shall 1 2 be the total for all lots in the series. Where a series of lots is not followed by "inclusive", the amount 3 appearing after such series shall be the assessment for each lot in the series. Section 4. The assessments made pursuant hereto shall be a lien in the several amounts
 assessed against each lot or tract of land set forth in Section 3 herein, and such lien shall have the
 priority of the lien for local public improvement districts.

Section 5. Without demand, said assessments as set forth in Section 3 herein, shall be due and payable on the first day of January of the year next following the year in which this assessing ordinance became effective, and said assessments shall become delinquent if not paid by the last day of February of the year next following the year in which this assessing ordinance became effective. A failure to pay said assessments as hereinabove set forth shall become a lien on the property subject to the assessment, and such lien may be sold by the City as provided by the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.

Section 6. Any unspent revenue and revenue generated through investment shall be
 retained and credited to Delgany Street Local Maintenance District for future long term or program
 maintenance of the District.
