

CdeBaca Amendment to the Mayor's Proposed 2020 Budget **20-1258**

Madam President: I move that the Mayor's Proposed 2021 Budget be amended in the following particulars:

- 1. On page 591, in the line titled "Police Patrol Districts Division" (In Appropriation 3510000) reduce the amount in the 2021 Recommended column by \$300,000.
- 2. On page 411, in the line titled "Services and Supplies" (In Appropriation 0144000) increase the amount in the 2021 Recommended column by \$300,000 from \$21,475,162 to \$21,775,162 to increase funding for trash collection services for homeless encampments.
- 3. Make other appropriate adjustments to comments, tables, schedules, and figures in the Mayor's Proposed 2021 Budget as may be required to reflect the actions in this amendment.

Explanation: This funding will provide HOST the resources to provide trash services for homeless encampments. Because the CDC recommends homeless encampments remain intact during the COVID-19 pandemic to ensure the health and safety of our unhoused residents, providing waste removal services for encampments allows residents to live with dignity and minimal impact to housed neighbors.
