PMAM facilitates the City's security alarm program. In Denver, all security alarms are required to be permitted. PMAM provides endto-end management of the City's security alarm ordinance. The scope of work allows for the intake, payment of issuance of new and renewed permits. Once a permit is issued, PMAM maintains digital connection to 911 dispatch and DPD allowing for these agencies to know, in real time, if an active alarm is associated with an active valid permit. If a customers violate the requirements of the ordinance (with false alarms or other issues) PMAM's system allows for the issuance and adjudication of enforcement citations.
