A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing cash transfers to close Funds in the General Government Fund Series, the Culture and Recreation Fund Series, and the Grant and Other Money Projects Fund Series, and authorizing cash transfers.

WHEREAS, in ongoing efforts to manage funds and reconcile cash, the Capital Planning and Programming Division (CPP) of the Department of Finance has performed a review of Arts and Venues Special Revenue Funds to identify inactive funds and take steps to close them; and

WHEREAS, CPP identified three Special Revenue Funds and two capital project funds that are no longer being used and can be closed; and

WHEREAS, said Funds have positive or negative cash balances that must be zeroed out before closing; and

WHEREAS, remaining cash in said Funds with positive cash balances will be transferred to the Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund and then transferred to the Funds with negative balances for said close out;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. There is hereby authorized the transfer of cash from the Special Revenue Funds and the Grant and Other Money Projects Fund to the Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund in the amounts indicated in the following tabulation:
