15	WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver will now be better served by the discontinuation o			
16	the Denver Welfare Reform Board and the transfer and undertaking of any residual matters by the			
17	Denver Department of Human Services and its Board of Human Services.			
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF

20	Section 1. The City and County of Denver shall discontinue using the Denver Welfare			
21	Reform Board to promulgate and adopt any rules, policies, or regulations pertaining to the			
22	functions, duties, and responsibilities related to PRWORA;			
23	Section 2. The City and County of Denver shall discontinue using the Denver Welfare			
24	Reform Board to approve the annual performance contract between Denver and the State			
25	Department of Human Services;			
26	Section 3. All functions previously performed by the Denver Welfare Reform Board shall			
27	be transferred to and undertaken by the Denver Department of Human Services and its Board of			
28	Human Services pursuant to Denver Charter §§ 2.10.3 and 2.10.4 and §26-1-116, C.R.S.			
29	Section 4. Ordinance No. 673, Series 1997, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
