12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:			
13	WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver, Colorado (the "City") previously adopted			
14				
15	the City's sponsorship of the metroDPA Program (the "Program") to provide competitive			
16	mortgage loans for low- and moderate-income persons and families intended for use as the sol			
17	place of residence by the owners or intended occupants and to promote the public health,			
18	welfare, safety, convenience and prosperity of the people of the City; and			
19 20	WHEREAS, capitalized terms used herein but not otherwise defined shall have the meaning assigned to such terms in the Original Ordinance; and			
21	WHEREAS, the Original Ordinance delegated to the Chief Financial Officer and/or the			
22	Executive Director of the City's Office of Economic Development certain authority to operate the			
23	Program; and			
24	WHEREAS, on September 27, 2019 Executive Order 145 was signed, thereby creating			
25	the Department of Housing Stability ("HOST") in the City, and providing the Executive			
26	Director/Chief Housing Officer of HOST the authority to govern in matters requiring action in			
27	response to housing stability, homelessness resolution, and housing opportunity, except where			
28	authority is otherwise granted by applicable federal, state or local law or regulation; and			
29	WHEREAS, administration of the Program has been moved from the Department of			
30	Finance ("Finance") and the Office of Economic Development to Finance and HOST; and			
31	WHEREAS, the Original Ordinance appointed George K. Baum & Company ("George K			

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Baum") as the administrator of the Program; and

WHEREAS, George K. Baum sold certain of its assets to Stifel, Nicolaus & Company, Incorporated ("Stifel"), and Stifel assumed George K. Baum's rights and obligations thereunder; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Original Ordinance to change the delegation of authority to operate the Program from Finance or the Office of Economic Development to Finance or HOST; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Original Ordinance to change all references from George K. Baum to Stifel;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 4 of the Original Ordinance is hereby amended and restated to change the Executive Director of the City's Office of Economic Development to the Executive Director/Chief Housing Officer of HOST as follows:

The form, terms and provisions of the Program Documents are hereby approved; with such changes and modifications as the appropriate officers of the City deem necessary and advisable; and the City shall execute and deliver the Program Documents, in substantially the form heretofore filed with the Council and to be filed with the City Clerk; and the Chief Financial Officer or Executive Director/Chief Housing Officer of the City's Department of Housing Stability is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Program Documents.

Section 2. Section 6 of the Original Ordinance is hereby amended and restated to add the Executive Director/Chief Housing Officer of HOST as follows:

The Chief Financial Officer of the City or the Executive Director/Chief Housing Officer of the Department of Housing Stability is hereby delegated to retain a Program Monitor, Escrow Agent and any servicer under a Seller and Servicing Agreement Wholesale.

Section 3. Section 10 of the Original Ordinance is hereby amended and restated to change the Executive Director of the City's Office of Economic Development to the Executive Director/Chief Housing Officer of the Department of Housing Stability as follows:

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The Council hereby authorizes all ancillary agreements and amendments to the Program Documents that are necessary for the Program. The Council hereby delegates to the Chief Financial Officer or Executive Director/Chief Housing Officer of the City's Department of Housing Stability the power to execute any and all documents relating to the Program and the power to execute any and all amendments to the Program Documents, including extensions and modifications to the terms of the Program, adding additional servicers and taking any actions necessary to administer and manage the Program consistent with the transactions contemplated by this Ordinance.

- **Section 4.** All reference to "George K. Baum & Company" in the Original Ordinance are hereby changed to "Stifel, Nicolaus & Company, Incorporated."
- **Section 5.** Notwithstanding anything contained in the Original Ordinance, the Program shall continue to serve and shall serve persons and families that earn 150% or less of the area median income for the City and County of Denver, Colorado.
- **Section 6.** All actions consistent with the provisions of this Ordinance heretofore taken by the Council and the officers of the City directed toward the Program are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.
- **Section 7.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.
- **Section 8.** All bylaws, orders, resolutions, ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency, and if so repealed, no other bylaw, order, resolution, ordinance, or part thereof, shall be revived. This repealer shall not be construed as reviving any bylaw, order, resolution or ordinance, or part thereof.
