5 **A BILL**

6 **For an ordinance dissolving the Tennyson Street Pedestrian Mall Local**  
7 **Maintenance District and directing that the remaining funds thereof, after**  
8 **payment of outstanding expenses, be transferred to the General Fund in**  
9 **accordance with Denver Revised Municipal Code Section 20-211.**

10 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 626, Series 1988, created the Local Maintenance District  
11 commonly known as the Tennyson Street Pedestrian Mall Local Maintenance District ("1988 LMD");  
12 and

13 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. No. 654, Series 1998, created the Local Maintenance District  
14 commonly known as the Tennyson Street II Pedestrian Mall Local Maintenance District ("1998  
15 LMD"); and

16 **WHEREAS**, all maintenance responsibilities of the 1988 LMD have been assumed by either  
17 the 1998 LMD or other parties; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the creation and ongoing existence of the 1998 LMD has rendered the services  
19 that the 1988 LMD was intended to provide redundant and, to avoid a duplication of services, the  
20 City desires to dissolve the 1988 LMD and transfer the remaining funds of the 1988 LMD, following  
21 payment of outstanding expenses, to the General Fund in accordance with Denver Revised  
22 Municipal Code Sec. 20-211.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**  
24 **DENVER:**

25 **Section 1.** That Council hereby finds that, to avoid a duplication of services, the 1988 LMD  
26 shall be dissolved and will no longer exist except as may be necessary to wind up business at the  
27 discretion of the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure of the City  
28 and County of Denver. Any funds remaining in the accounts of the 1988 LMD, following the payment  
29 of outstanding expenses, shall be transferred to the General Fund as provided in Denver Revised  
30 Municipal Code Sec. 20-211.
