10	WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the Denver Zoning Code (the "Code")updating		
11	the way the Code regulates households, consolidating residential care uses into a single system		
12	regulated by size rather than the population served, and establishing a new congregate living use		
13	category that allows for the evolution of residential uses that are not in conventional dwelling units;

16	presented at the public hearing that amending the Denver Zoning Code as set forth herein is		
17	consistent with the City's adopted plans, furthers the public health, safety and general welfare, and

19	households, residential care uses and congregate living, providing predictability to applicants and		
20	the community; and

22	explore opportunities to improve neighborhood inspections with a focus on data, community voices,		
23	and achieving equitable outcomes for all.

The changes to the Denver Zoning Code as set forth in Clerk File No. 202100002 as filed with the Denver City Clerk on January 7, 2021, and available in the office and on the web page of City Council are hereby adopted and made an official part of the Denver Zoning Code. The changes amend certain provisions of the Denver Zoning Code to ensure and promote equitable access to housing for all Denver residents, address homelessness and reduce obstacles to affordability.
