This contract provides maintenance of the existing cameras and infrastructure utilized to produce video through the City's Milestone VMS system, warranty replacement of cameras and other equipment within the warranty period and the ability to purchase and install additional cameras in needed/requested areas..

- **Length of Usage** Denver has been utilizing HALO cameras to enhance officer and citizen safety since 2008. This program has grown over the past 12 years and has expanded geographically within the City.
- Workflow Continuity DPD regularly imports video files directly into Evidence.com. These video files are initially received into Milestone from the HALO cameras. The video files that are imported into Evidence.com are utilized for multiple purposes. These purposes include but are not limited to; lawsuits brought against the City; evidence for prosecution of crimes committed against the citizens of Denver. These files are regularly shared with the City and District Attorney's offices. These files are also utilized to share evidence with defense attorneys for discovery requests, as well as the sharing of evidence for CORA requests through Civil Liability.
- Continuity of Service DPD currently utilizes the HALO system to provide officers with real time situational awareness on existing calls where cameras exist. Operators within the Real Time Crime Center (RTCC) also will generate calls for service when they observe crimes in progress where 911 calls have yet to be placed. The integration of the Milestone system with Evidence.com supports the organization, retention schedules, and searchability of DPD's digital evidence. The use of this system has become a main point of reference for crimes that have occurred as well as complaints against officers of the Denver Police Department. A break in this service would be a detriment to the safety of the citizens and the security of the City of Denver.
- **Training** The HALO system also provides video to be utilized in training. After approval through the chain of command, incidents that have been caught on camera can be utilized for training purposes.
