7 8 9	For an ordinance adding a new section 2-6 to Article 1, Chapter 2, formally recognizing Juneteenth.			
10	WHEREAS, on June 19, 1865, Major General Gordon Granger delivered news that the Civil			
11	War had ended and enslaved people were now free to residents of Galveston, $TX -$ the last area lef			
12	to formally acknowledge this reality – almost 2 ½ years after President Abraham Lincoln issued the			
13	Emancipation Proclamation on January 1, 1863; and,			
14	WHEREAS, commemoration of the end of slavery has since been celebrated as Juneteenth,			
15	beginning first as a holiday in Texas and now formally as a day of observance in 45 states across the			
16	nation and in the District of Columbia; and,			
17	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council encourage Colorado to join the ranks of those states			
18	formally commemorating Juneteenth and encourage the Federal government to likewise act to			
19	acknowledge the continued tradition of Juneteenth; and,			
20	WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has a long and storied history of celebrating			
21	Juneteenth, with the first celebration happening in 1953 in Denver's historic Five Points neighborhood,			
22	and today includes an annual parade and music festival; and,			
23	WHEREAS, Denver is committed to racial and social justice and Juneteenth represents an			
24	opportunity for celebrating African-American freedom, heritage and achievement while also			
25	encouraging education, healing and respect,			
26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF			
27	DENVER:			
28	Section 1. That Article I of Chapter 2, D.R.M.C. shall be amended by adding a new section 2-6			
29	to read as follows:			
30	Sec 2-6. – Juneteenth.			
31	On the Saturday closest to June 19th in each year, hereafter to be known as "Juneteenth,"			
32	appropriate observance may be held by the public in commemoration and to honor the spirit of			
33	freedom and understanding the experiences that have shaped our nation.			
34	Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and final publication.
