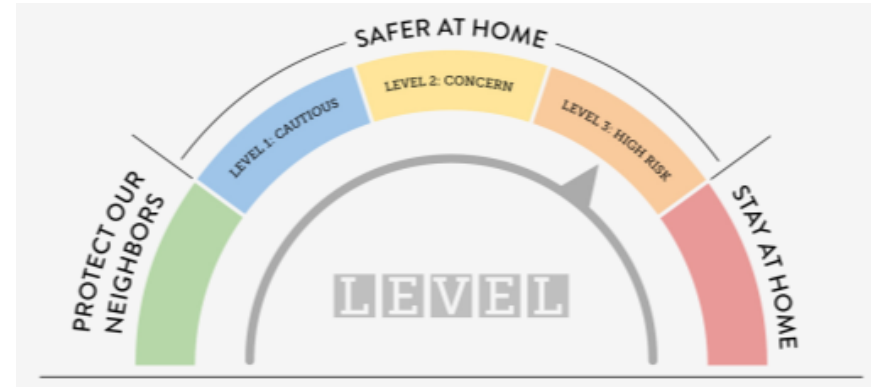

Strategic Testing

- Focus on underserved communities
- Five Tactics
 - Denver Health Clinics
 - Denver Public Health Mobile Outreach Testing Teams
 - DDPHE Residential Testing Teams
 - DDPHE Mobile Outreach Testing Teams
 - DDPHE Fixed Community Testing Sites
- Current demand is approximately 5,000 per day

Fixed Community Testing Sites

Four Locations

- Denver Human Services East
 - Green Valley Ranch Pool
 - Paco Sanchez Park
 - Ruby Hill Park
-
- Operate 7 days a week
 - Staffed by over 100 temporary Emergency Service Workers and City staff
 - Capacity to test over 2,000 people per day
 - Current demand is about 500 tests per day

Agreement Terms

Testing Contractor

- Provide staffing and management for up to 6 fixed community testing sites
- Ability to expand testing to additional locations or compress number of sites
- Weekly cost per site
 - Supervisor
 - Team Leads
 - Testing Staff
- On-call contract expires June 2021
- Maximum agreement amount: \$4,000,000
- Funding source: Enhanced Laboratory Capacity (ELC) Grant

Additional Details

- All Site Supervisors and Site Leads must be appropriately trained as “Key Personnel” qualified to oversee the testing staff, equipment, supplies, and customer service
- Contractor will set-up for testing operations, collect COVID-19 specimens per City standards, and pack-up at the end of each day.
- Contractor’s staff will adhere to safety protocols, HIPPA regulations, and hazardous waste disposal requirements. The contractor will track inventory of City- provided PPE
- Contractor will coordinate safe removal of hazardous materials

— Additional Benefits

Free up key staff resources for other operational areas including:

- DDPHE residential testing
- DDPHE mobile testing
- Vaccination efforts
