26	Section 1. The changes to the Denver Zoning Code as set forth in Clerk File No. 202100002

29	changes amend certain provisions of the Denver Zoning Code to ensure and promote equitable			
30	access to housing for all Denver residents, address homelessness and reduce obstacles to			

affordability.
