The City and County of Denver Office of the City Forester (OCF) is seeking qualified contractors for on-call contract services related to tree maintenance throughout the City, including locations on private property

Purpose and Use of Agreements:

The purpose of these On-Call contracts is to establish and maintain a pool of qualified On-Call General Tree Contractors available to respond to proposal bidding requests for the execution of the OCF 3-year, \$1.5 Million work plan.

Services include tree pruning, tree removal, stump removal, stump grinding, filling of stump holes, and/or debris removal on public property, public rights-of-way, emergency tree work, including such work as necessary to resolve a violation of the Revised Municipal Code.

Procurement:

Six (6) firms submitted qualification submittals which were reviewed and scored. Of those submittals, three (3) firms were selected.

Contracts Description:

Each contract has a three (3) year term and a capacity of \$5 million. The firms selected for these agreements are listed alphabetically.

- Acme Tree Service
- Bear Creek Tree Service
- Environmental Tree Care, LLC

These contracts do not commit funds, nor do they guarantee any amount to the firms. These contracts are not an authorization of work. Authorization or work and commitment of funds are made via task notices on an as needed basis.
