## **Executive Summary**

Aramark Services was contracted to provide beverage services at the Denver Coliseum Auxiliary Shelter. The facility was
established in April of 2020 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic for people experiencing homelessness. This amendment seeks to
extend the provision of services through September 30, 2021 with an option to extend at least ten (10) days prior the expiration of the
term.

The auxiliary shelter for men at the Denver Coliseum provides 24/7 sheltering with a capacity of up to 300 guests. Sheltering operations are administered by the Denver Rescue Mission, and this effort includes medical screening of all guests at entry by the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless. This beverage contract is eligible for reimbursement from FEMA.

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
