



GREAT HALL PROJECT




- Improves security of TSA checkpoints
- Meets passenger growth demands
 - Terminal only built for 50 million annual passengers
 - 69 million annual passengers in 2019
 - 39 new gates operational by early 2022; first gates opened November of 2020
- Enhances passenger experience and operational efficiency



GREAT HALL PROJECT – PHASE 1




- Foundational work on building structure and systems
- Modernizes ticket lobbies with automated self bag drops
- New and upgraded restrooms, escalators and elevators, HVAC
- More spacious and efficient passenger flow
- On budget and on track to complete in Q4 2021










EAST SIDE DECK EXTENSION








SELF BAG DROP INSTALLATION







GREAT HALL PROJECT – PHASE 2



- Design nearing completion
- Construction activities commence Q2 2021
- Major elements
 - Steel deck expansion on Level 6 west scheduled for completion in Q3 2022
 - Level 6 west security checkpoints scheduled for completion in Q4 2023
- Substantial completion in Q2 2024



GREAT HALL PROJECT – PHASE 2




- Builds a new Level 6 security checkpoint on the west side and replaces an existing Level 5 checkpoint
 - Adds five security lanes with the ability to install more efficient technology
 - Makes improvements to the remaining Level 5 security checkpoint
- Opportunity to activate space on Level 5 with new concessions and improved meeter/greeter space
- Completion in Q2 2024


