**A RESOLUTION**

**Laying out, opening and establishing as part of the City street system a parcel of land as a public alley bounded by East 14th Avenue, North Trenton Street, East Colfax Avenue and North Tamarac Street; and, a parcel of land as East Colfax Avenue located at the intersection of North Trenton Street and East Colfax Avenue.**

**WHEREAS**, the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure of the City and County of Denver has found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity require the laying out, opening and establishing as a public alley designated as part of the system of thoroughfares of the municipality those portions of real property hereinafter more particularly described, and, subject to approval by resolution has laid out, opened and established the same as a public street and as a public alley;

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** That the action of the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure in laying out, opening and establishing as part of the system of thoroughfares of the municipality the following described portion of real property situate, lying and being in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, to wit:

**LAND DESCRIPTION – ALLEY PARCEL**

A portion of a parcel of land conveyed by Special Warranty Deed to the City and County of Denver, recorded on the 28th day of April, 2017, at Reception Number 2017056359 in the City and County of Denver Clerk and Recorder's Office, lying in the northwest quarter of Section 4, Township 4 South, Range 67 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, more particularly described as follows:

The west 2.00 feet of the east 10.00 feet of Lots 1 through 10, inclusive, Block 7, KENSINGTON, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

The north 7.00 feet of Lot 1, Block 7, KENSINGTON, except the east 10.00 feet thereof, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.
